

## Great Plains Traditional Bows

Recommended Brace Heights measured from the throat of grip to string:

One Piece Recurve: 8 ¼" – 8 ½"

Take Down Recurve: 60", 62", and 64" — 8¼— 8 ½"  
58"—8"—8 ⅜"

SR Swift Take Down Recurve: 8 ⅛" – 8 ½"

One Piece Long Curve: 7 ½ " – 8"

Take Down Texas Long Curve: 7 ½ " – 8"

Longbows: 58", 60", 62", 64" — 6 ¼" - 6 ½ "  
66", 68" — 6 ½" — 7 ¼ "

Three Piece Take down Longbows: 60", 62", 64" — 6 ¼" - 6 ½"  
66", 68" — 6 ½" — 7 ¼ "

**TO PREVENT PERSONAL INJURY AND DAMAGE TO YOUR BOW, USE A BOW STRINGER AT ALL TIMES.**

NEVER DRY-FIRE THE BOW.

Nock arrow under nocking point

Store your bow in a cool, dry place and avoid prolonged exposure to excessive heat and moisture.

If you leave the bow strung, hang the bow horizontally.



Limb tips are reinforced with Phenolic for Fast Flight strings.

Adult supervision is recommended when children are using a bow.
